

 30 preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

32 **FISCAL NOTE**

34 The increase of the county tax assessment by \$24,676 for  
 36 municipalities in Piscataquis County represents a state mandate.  
 Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all  
 38 members elected to each House exempts the State from the  
 constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local  
 costs.
