Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Public Law 1993, chapter 355, section 65 6 transferred ownership of a building on the campus of Southern Maine Technical College to the Department of Environmental 8 Protection; and

10 Whereas, there is an immediate need to clear the title to that building in order to allow Southern Maine Technical College
 12 full control over the building to expand its classroom space; and

14 Whereas, the Maine Technical College System and the Department of Environmental Protection are jointly proposing this
16 legislation to change the effect of Public Law 1993, chapter 355, section 65; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. PL 1993, c. 355, §65 is repealed.

Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act takes effect retroactively to June 16, 1993.

STATEMENT OF FACT

38 During the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature, a provision was inserted in Public Law 1993, chapter 355 to
 40 transfer ownership of a building on the campus of Southern Maine Technical College to the Department of Environmental Protection.
 42 This bill is being presented jointly by the Governor, the Department of Environmental Protection and the Maine Technical
 44 College System to repeal the portion of Public Law 1993, chapter 355 that transferred ownership of the Southern Maine Technical
