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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1413, L.D. 1923, Bill, "An  
Act to Provide Equity in the Laws Concerning Tax Exemptions for  
Veterans"

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Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph D-1 in the 8th line  
(page 1, line 47 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "801"  
and inserting in its place the following: '801 2101'

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Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph D-1 in the  
3rd line from the end (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out  
the following: "shall apply" and inserting in its place the  
following: 'shall-apply applies'

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Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

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**FISCAL NOTE**

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This bill includes a new property tax exemption for certain  
veterans of active military service during other than any  
federally recognized war period. Pursuant to the Constitution of  
Maine, the State is required to reimburse municipalities for 50%  
of the lost property tax revenue due to new or expanded  
exemptions. Additional General Fund appropriations of \$5,000  
annually will be required beginning in fiscal year 1995-96.'

**COMMITTEE AMENDMENT**

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment corrects a reference to the United States Code and conforms existing law to current drafting standards. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
