HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1414, L.D. 1924, Bill, "An Act to Improve Licensing Procedures at the Bureau of Insurance"

Amend the bill in section 35 in that part designated "**§3105**" in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 13, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "executes" the following: 'through an attorney-in-fact'

Further amend the bill in section 35 in that part designated "**§3105**" in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd line (page 13, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "State" the following: '; except that bonds executed by an officer of this insurer are exempt from this requirement'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment restricts the requirement for powers of attorney attached to bonds. It creates an exemption for bonds executed by an officer of the insurer.
