22	Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4-D by inserting
24	at the end the following: ' <u>"Genetically engineered food" does</u> not include a food developed exclusively through traditional
26	<u>methods of breeding, such as artificial insemination, embryo</u> <u>transfer, hybridization or nondirected mutagenesis, nor does it</u>
28	<u>include foods containing extracted products of a genetically</u> engineered organism with no more than trace amounts of the
30	organism itself or its genetic material.'
	Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4-E by
32	inserting at the end the following: ' <u>"Genetically engineered</u> food organism" does not include a food organism developed
34	<u>exclusively through traditional methods of breeding, such as</u> artificial insemination, embryo transfer, hybridization or
36	nondirected mutagenesis.
38	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

42	'FISCAL NOTE
	The Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will
44	incur some minor additional costs to oversee the requirement that genetically engineered food be labeled by retailers. These costs
46	can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 713, L.D. 1928

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

12 This amendment refines the definition of "genetically engineered food" and "genetically engineered food organism" to exclude those foods and organisms created by traditional breeding methods and foods that contain products extracted from 16 genetically engineered organisms that contain only trace amounts of the organism or its genetic material.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
