COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 715, L.D. 1930, "Resolve, to Create the Blue Ribbon Commission on Hunger and Food Security"

Amend the bill in section 9 by striking out the last line (page 2, line 20 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'All Other \$7,000'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$7,000

This bill includes a General Fund appropriation of \$7,000 in fiscal year 1994-95 for the Legislature for the expenses of the Blue Ribbon Commission on Hunger and Food Security. The additional costs to provide staff assistance to the Blue Ribbon Commission on Hunger and Food Security can be absorbed by the State Planning Office and the Department of Human Services within existing budgeted resources.'
