Further amend the amendment in the 11th indented paragraph after the title in the question in the first line (page 2, line 25 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$10,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$15,000,000'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 116th Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$18,795,000 with principal payments of \$15,000,000, and interest payments of approximately \$3,795,000.

In addition, the Department of Education will be requesting future General Fund appropriations estimated to be approximately \$1,400,000 per year for the operating costs associated with the upgrade and expansion of the interactive television system. These lower operating costs are predicated on a phased-in approach toward implementing the distance learning network whereby approximately 1/2 of Maine's high schools will participate under this bond issue.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment increases the principal amount from \$10,000,000 to \$15,000,000, increases the length of the bond authorization from 5 years to 10 years, changes the referendum date from June 1994 to November 1994 and replaces the fiscal note.
