SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 720, L.D. 1942, Bill, "An Act to Clarify and Make Technical Changes to Various Professional Licensing Board Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section A-12 the following:

'Sec. 13. 32 MRSA §14202, sub-§12 is enacted to read:

12. Tanning device. "Tanning device" means any equipment that emits electromagnetic radiation with wavelengths in the air between 200 and 400 nanometers and is used for tanning of human skin, including a sunlamp, tanning booth or tanning bed.

Sec. 14. 32 MRSA §14224, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

2-A. Operation of tanning device; public access. An establishment in which a tanning device is operated on the effective date of this subsection is not required to partition off the working area of the establishment or maintain a separate entrance in order to provide public access to the tanning device. If such an establishment undergoes a material alteration or adds more tanning devices, then the establishment may be prohibited from providing public access to the tanning device through the working area.'

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment to the committee amendment adds a definition of tanning device to the laws regulating barbering and cosmetology. The amendment also grandfathers any barber shop or beauty salon that operates a tanning device from being required to partition off the working area of the establishment or to have a separate entrance for the tanning device in order to provide access for the public. If the structure of the shop is materially changed, or more tanning devices are added, then the shop loses the exemption.
