
SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 724, L.D. 1945, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Public Smoking Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in that part designated "\$1545." by inserting after the last paragraph the following:

'Nothing in this section may be construed to authorize the court to suspend or refuse to renew the license, certification, registration, permit, approval or other similar document evidencing authority to conduct business activities of any establishment that violates this chapter.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment specifies that the court may not suspend or refuse to renew the licenses of business establishments that violate the smoking laws.
