Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§2, ¶¶N and O are enacted to read:

4 N. Smoking is not prohibited in a pool hall or billiards
6 parlor.

8 O. If 2 or more activities described in this subsection are
10 conducted within a single enclosed area of a public place
12 and smoking is not prohibited for one activity, then smoking
14 is not prohibited throughout the entire enclosed area.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill exempts pool halls or billiard parlors from the
18 prohibition on public smoking. The bill also clarifies the
20 application of the public smoking law to mixed-use facilities.
22 If smoking is permitted for one of the activities conducted
24 within a single enclosed area, then smoking is permitted
26 throughout the entire enclosed area.

28 This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the
30 need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical
 amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
