STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the number of voting members on the Board of Trustees of the Maine School of Science and Mathematics from 18 to 17 and the number of nonvoting members from one to 2. The amendment clarifies that one of the members who is a teacher is a nonvoting member. The amendment also clarifies the board's duties pertaining to the geographical basis for selection of students who will attend the school.

The amendment also makes a technical correction.
