COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1434, L.D. 1961, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Maine Dairy and Nutrition Council and the Maine Dairy Promotion Board"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

**Sec. 6. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.
