HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to I.B. 2, L.D. 1983, "An Act to Impose Term Limits on Members of the United States Congress"


Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This legislation is an initiated bill. If not enacted in its present form, this bill must be submitted to the voters. The estimated cost of sending this bill out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 116th Legislature for submission to the voters at the November 1994 general election. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.'
