HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1459, L.D. 1984, Bill, "An Act to Conserve Sea Urchin Resources"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "~~§6749-N.~~" and inserting in its place the following:

'§6749-N. Closed areas; 1995 to 1998

Notwithstanding section 6749, in calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998, it is unlawful for a person to fish for or take sea urchins from April 15th to September 15th, both days inclusive.'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "~~§6749-P.~~"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§6749-Q.~~" in subsection 5 in the last paragraph in the last line (page 3, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~6749-R~~" and inserting in its place the following: '6749-Q'


Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§6749-R.~~" in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~6749-Q~~" and inserting in its place the following: '6749-P'

Further amend the bill in section 2 by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

HOUSE AMENDMENT

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes those provisions of the bill that establish 2 fishing zones in coastal waters and that establish closed fishing seasons in each zone. This amendment establishes a new closed season for sea urchin harvesting that applies to all coastal waters for calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998.
