This bill establishes the Sea Urchin Research Fund within the Department of Marine Resources to be funded by the establishment of certain license surcharges. The estimated annual increase of dedicated revenue to the department is \$397,620 beginning in fiscal year 1994-95. The department will require allocations of \$397,620 annually beginning in fiscal year 1994-95 to authorize expenditures for research directly related to sea urchin fishery management information needs and the costs of one half-time Marine Resources Specialist I position and general operating costs to administer and analyze sea urchin buyer and processor logbook requirements.

The Department of Marine Resources will also require an additional Other Special Revenue allocation of \$5,000 in fiscal year 1994-95 for the costs of developing sea urchin buyer and processor logbook requirements. The department is authorized to recover certain costs associated with the logbook requirements

through fees to those sea urchin buyers and processors who are required to maintain logbooks, which will generate \$5,000 of dedicated revenue beginning in fiscal year 1994-95.

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The Department of Marine Resources will incur some minor enforce certain sea urchin additional costs to limitations. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

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This bill establishes a new Class D crime. imposed for Class D offenses must be served in a county jail. The average cost per sentence for a Class D crime is \$8,320 based upon an average length of stay of 119 days. The additional costs to the counties for the housing of each offender sentenced under this new crime are not reimbursed by the State.

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The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund appropriations to cover indigent defense costs related to these new cases. The amounts can not be estimated at this time. additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be the budgeted the absorbed within resources οf Department's administrative account. The collection additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the name of a "sea urchin boat "sea urchin dragging license" for purposes clarification.

The amendment also strikes that part of the bill that prohibited a person from participating in the sea urchin fishery unless they had possessed a 1993 license or purchased their 1994 license before March 3, 1994. Under this amendment, a person not previously licensed is allowed to purchase a 1994 license until 90 days after adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 116th Legislature. Possession of a 1994 sea urchin dragging license is a prerequisite for participation in the fishery during the 4-year period of limited entry proposed in the bill.

The amendment also includes authorization for personnel and operating costs associated with the logbook to be paid from allocations from the Sea Urchin Research Fund. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
