SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1459, L.D. 1984, Bill, "An Act to Conserve Sea Urchin Resources"

Amend the bill in section 2 by inserting at the end and before section 3 the following:

§6749-U. Vinalhaven Island; closed area

Notwithstanding section 6749-N, subsection 2, a person may not fish for or take sea urchins within one mile of Vinalhaven Island from May 1st to November 1st.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment prohibits harvesting of sea urchins within one mile of Vinalhaven Island from May 1st to November 1st during calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998.
