SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1459, L.D. 1984, Bill, "An Act to Conserve Sea Urchin Resources"

Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§6749-P.~~" in the first paragraph by striking out all of the first 2 underlined sentences (page 2, lines 29 to 33 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: 'For calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998, a person eligible to purchase a license under section 6749-0 may purchase a license that is valid for both Zone 1 and Zone 2.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows a licensee to harvest sea urchins in both zones designated by the bill, instead of limiting the licensee to one of the 2 zones.
