HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1466, L.D. 1993, Bill, "An Act to Demonstrate the Value the State Places on a Strong, Competitive and Sustainable Paper Industry"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5264.~~" in the first paragraph in the 4th line from the end (page 6, line 37 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "municipality." the following: 'The designation of the development district must be submitted to and approved by the legal voters living in the municipality at a town meeting that is called, advertised and conducted according to the laws relating to municipal elections.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by adding language that requires the designation of the development district to be voted on by the legal voters of the municipality.
