SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1466, L.D. 1993, Bill, "An Act to Demonstrate the Value the State Places on a Strong, Competitive and Sustainable Paper Industry"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§5263.~~" in subsection 10 in the 4th line (page 6, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "26" and inserting in its place the following: '261, 262 or 263 or those activities classified under 2679 that press or mold wood pulp or recycled fiber to make products'
