SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 773, L.D. 1996, "Resolve, to Establish a Commission on the Future of Maine's Paper Industry"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "7" and inserting in its place the following: '8'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Three" and inserting in its place the following: 'Four'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the last paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "finance;" and inserting in its place the following: 'finance. One member must represent the interests of the environment and one member must represent the interests of labor;'

Further amend the resolve in section 9 in the 3rd line (page 4, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Legislature and" and inserting in its place the following: 'Legislature,'

Further amend the resolve in section 9 in the next to the last line (page 4, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "matters" the following: 'and to the Maine Economic Growth Council as established under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 929-A'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 10 and inserting in its place the following:

the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted resources.'


40 This amendment adds an 8th member to the Commission on the  
42 Future of Maine's Paper Industry. It requires that one of the  
members appointed to the commission must represent the interests  
44 of the environment and one member must represent the interests of  
labor.

46 The amendment requires that the commission submit its report  
48 to the Maine Economic Growth Council as well as to the  
Legislature and the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and  
50 Economic Development.
