HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1474, L.D. 2002, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Authorization of the Towns of Appleton, Camden, Hope, Lincolnville and Rockport to Form a Community School District"

Amend the bill in section 6 in that part designated "Sec. 24." in the 5th and 6th lines (page 7, lines 23 and 24 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Hope and Lincolnville" and inserting in its place the following: 'Appleton, Hope and Lincolnville that are municipal members of the district'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires the Town of Appleton to hold a special town meeting to vote on joining a community school district. The additional costs of this state mandate are anticipated to be minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'
