SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 776, L.D. 2003, "Resolve, Authorizing the Examination of School Finance and Taxation Proposals"

Amend the resolve in section 5 in the last line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1995." and inserting in its place the following: '1995; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 5 the following:

Sec. 6. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

1994-95

APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS

General Fund \$6,800

The Legislature will require a General Fund appropriation of \$6,800 in fiscal year 1994-95 for the per diem, expenses and miscellaneous costs of a subcommittee of Legislators established to review and analyze issues related to the current tax structure for funding public schools.

The State Board of Education may require an additional General Fund appropriation for the costs associated with holding statewide public hearings related to the proposed School Finance Act of 1994. The amount required will depend on the number of hearings that are required.

The additional costs to review and analyze proposals related to essential educational services can be absorbed by the Department of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.'
