HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1480, L.D. 2006, Bill, "An Act to Establish Procedures for Secession and Annexation"

Amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~§2170.~~" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 6, line 48 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "at least 2/3" and inserting in its place the following: 'a majority'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "~~§2173.~~" in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the last line (page 7, line 51 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2/3" and inserting in its place the following: 'a majority'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the vote required for approval of the voters from a 2/3 majority to a simple majority.
