SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to "Senate Order Adopting the 116th Senate Rules"

Amend the Senate Order by striking out all of Senate Rule 33 and inserting in its place the following:

'33. No rule shall be dispensed with, except by the consent of two thirds of the members present. Notwithstanding this rule, after the convening of the First Regular Session and before January 26, 1993, any amendment to the Senate Rules proposed by a Senate Order may be adopted by a majority vote of the members present, except that if the amendment has already failed to be adopted during that session, it may be adopted only if, upon reconsideration, it receives the approval of 2/3 of the members present.'

This amendment allows the Senate to amend Senate Rules before January 26, 1993 by a simple majority vote.


