HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to "House Order Concerning the Resignation of John L. Martin as Speaker of the House of Representatives"

Amend the House Order by striking out all of the last 2 paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'Ordered, that the resignation of John L. Martin as Speaker of the House of Representatives be accepted to be effective immediately; and be it further

Ordered, that an election be held by January 13, 1994 to elect the Speaker of the House.'
