24	In Joint Rule 13, strike out all of that part related to "Membership." and insert in its place the following:
26	'Membership. Each of these committees shall consist of no more than 3 on the part of the Senate and no more than 10 on the
28	part of the House. The first named Senate member shall be the Senate chair. The House chair shall be elected by majority vote
30	of the House members of the committee and may only be removed, notwithstanding the Speaker's power to appoint committee members
32	in House Rule 1, by an affirmative vote of at least 2/3 of the
34	House members of the committee. The Senate chair shall preside and in the Senate chair's absence, the House chair shall preside
36	and, thereafter, as the need may arise, the chair shall alternate between the members from each House in the order of their appointment to the committee.''
