HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to S.P. 11, "Joint Order Adopting the
116th Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order by striking out all of the first
paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Rules of the
115th Legislature be adopted as the Joint Rules of the 116th
Legislature, except for the following changes.

Strike out all of Joint Rule 11 and insert in its place the
following:

'11. Employees. The salaries of all officers and employees
of the Senate and House of Representatives shall be established
by the Legislative Council. The Secretary of the Senate is
authorized and directed to certify vouchers of the officers and
employees of the Senate and the Clerk of the House is authorized
and directed to certify vouchers of the officers and employees of
the House in conformance with this Rule to the Executive Director
of the Legislative Council and said salaries shall be paid at
such intervals as the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the
House and the Majority Floor Leaders of both the House and the
Senate may determine.' '
