26	'Membership. Each of these committees shall consist of no more than 3 on the part of the Senate and no more than 10 on the
28	part of the House. Minority leaders of both houses shall appoint the minority members to their committee assignments on the
30	proportional basis reflecting the membership of the body. The first named Senate member shall be the Senate chair. The first
32	named House member shall be the House chair. The Senate chair shall preside and in the Senate chair's absence, the House chair
34	shall preside and, thereafter, as the need may arise, the chair
36	shall alternate between the members from each House in the order of their appointment to the committee.' '
