SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 11, "Joint Order Adopting the
116th Joint Rules"


Amend the Joint Order by inserting after Joint Rule 12 the
following:

'12-A. Records of Certain Legislator Expenses. The records
of expenditures for any individual Legislator's telephone calls
and postage are available for inspection by the majority or
minority leaders of that Legislator's chamber, upon the request
of a leader.'

Further amend the Joint Order to renumber any duplicate Rule
numbers to read alphanumerically.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that records of Legislator telephone
calls and postage expenditures are available upon request to the
majority and minority leaders of the Legislator's chamber.
