12 SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to S.P. 11, "Joint Order Adopting the 14 116th Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Rules of the 20 115th Legislature be adopted as the Joint Rules of the 116th Legislature, except for the following changes.

In Joint Rule 13, strike out all of that part designated "<u>Participation in Budget Hearings and Work Sessions.</u>" and insert in its place the following:

'Participation in Budget Hearings and Work Sessions. Each joint standing committee, except the Committee on Appropriations 28 and Financial Affairs, shall appoint a subcommittee of three of its members to attend and participate in Appropriations Committee 30 budget hearings and to attend and advise at working sessions dealing with that portion of the budget within their committee's 32 One member of the subcommittee shall be area of interest. appointed by the Senate chair and the remaining two members shall 34 be appointed by the House chair. This subcommittee must include members of both the majority and minority parties. 36 This subcommittee may advise the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs of their respective committee's recommendations 38 on these portions of the budget.' '
