12 SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 11, "Joint Order Adopting the 14 116th Joint Rules"

16 Amend the Joint Order by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Rules of the 20 115th Legislature be adopted as the Joint Rules of the 116th Legislature, except for the following changes.

Strike out all of Joint Rule 24 and Joint Rule 25 and insert 24 in their place the following:

26 '<u>24. Cloture for State Department, Agency or Commission</u> <u>Bills or Resolves.</u>

1. Deadlines for Requests. No request for a bill or 30 resolve may be submitted to the Revisor of Statutes on behalf of any state department, agency or commission after 32 the first Wednesday in December. If the Governor has been newly elected in November preceding the convening of the 34 first regular session, any bill or resolve introduced on behalf of a state department, agency or commission shall be 36 submitted within 30 days after the Governor is administered the oath of office.

Identification of Agency. Each bill or resolve
submitted for preparation under this rule shall clearly
designate, under the title, the department, agency or
commission upon whose behalf the bill or resolve is submitted.

SENATE AMENDMENT "/" to S.P. 11

3. After-Deadline Requests. Any request for a bill or resolve submitted under this rule after the first Wednesday in December in either the first or second regular session shall be considered an after-cloture request and shall be transmitted to the Legislative Council by the Revisor of Statutes. The Legislative Council shall consider the facts supporting introduction notwithstanding cloture. Ιf two-thirds of the Legislative Council approve the request the bill or resolve, it shall be accepted for for introduction. Notice of that action shall appear on the calendar of the appropriate House.

<u>4. Cloture Dates.</u> The Legislative Council may vary cloture dates by 2/3 vote for good cause.

16 25. Cloture at the First Regular Session. During any first regular session, all other requests for bills and resolves submitted by returning Legislators shall be submitted in complete 18 form to the Revisor of Statutes by 5:00 p.m. on the 2nd Friday in 20 Requests for bills and resolves submitted by new December. Legislators shall be submitted in complete form to the Revisor of 22 Statutes by 5:00 p.m. on the last Friday in December. The Legislative Council may vary cloture dates by 2/3 vote for good cause. 24

26 Presenters shall be notified by the Revisor of Statutes when the bill or resolve is ready for signature and shall be 28 responsible for reviewing and signing the bills and resolves in accordance with Joint Rule 32 to ensure timely introduction into 30 the appropriate House.

32 <u>Exception.</u> This rule shall not apply to bills or resolves reported by any joint committee in the regular course of
34 business, nor to such bills and resolves as are intended only to facilitate the business of the Legislature.' '

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies current practice that the Legislative Council may vary cloture dates for good cause and
also requires a 2/3 vote before a cloture date may be changed.
