SENATE AMENDMENT "J" to S.P. 11, "Joint Order Adopting the 116th Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'ORDERED, the House concurring, that the Joint Rules of the 115th Legislature be adopted as the Joint Rules of the 116th Legislature, except for the following changes.

Insert after Joint Rule 12 the following:

'12-A. Records of Certain Legislator Expenses. The records of expenditures for any individual Legislator's telephone calls and postage are available for inspection by the majority or minority leaders of that Legislator's chamber, upon the request of a leader.'

Renumber any duplicate Rule numbers to read alphanumerically.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that records of Legislator telephone calls and postage expenditures are available upon request to the majority and minority leaders of the Legislator's chamber.
