SENATE AMENDMENT " " to S.P. 96, "Joint Order to Implement Changes from the Joint Select Committee on Rules"

Amend the Joint Order in the Joint Rules by inserting after Joint Rule 12-C the following:

'12-D. Limit on Terms of Leadership. Beginning with the 116th Legislative Session, a member may not serve as President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House, leader of one of the parties or assistant leader or whip of one of the parties for more than 2 consecutive terms.'

Further amend the Joint Order to renumber any duplicate Rule numbers to read alphanumerically.
