

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to "JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO STOP MANDATES THAT ARE BEYOND ITS CONSTITUTIONALLY DELEGATED POWERS"

Amend the joint resolution on page 2 in the last paragraph by striking out the following: "the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of each state legislature in the nation and each member of the Maine Congressional Delegation" and inserting in its place the following: 'and the Majority leader of the United States Senate'
