SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to "JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO STOP MANDATES THAT ARE BEYOND ITS CONSTITUTIONALLY DELEGATED POWERS"

Amend the resolution on page 1 by striking out all of the 5th and 6th indented paragraphs after the title.

Further amend the resolution on page 1 in the 7th indented paragraph after the title in the first line by striking out the following: "are directly in" and inserting in its place the following: 'may be in direct'

Further amend the resolution on page 2 in the 9th indented paragraph after the title in the 3rd and 4th lines by striking out the following: "now, therefore, be it" and inserting in its place the following: 'and'

Further amend the resolution on page 2 by inserting after the 9th indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Whereas, the Congress of the United States has also passed numerous laws that have protected individual freedom and liberty and promoted the general welfare of all Americans, including, but not limited to, the Civil Rights Act and the Voting Rights Act; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend the resolution on page 2 by inserting before the last paragraph the following:
