Resolve, Directing the Department of Environmental Protection to Extend the Deadline for Licensure of the Transfer Station on Long Island.

(EMERGENCY)

Presented by Representative ADAMS of Portland. Cosponsored by Representative: MITCHELL of Portland, Senators: ABROMSON of Cumberland, MICHAUD of Penobscot, RAND of Cumberland. **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the temporary license for the municipal solid waste 6 transfer station on Long Island expires on December 16, 1994; and

8 Whereas, additional time is needed for Long Island to clarify and comply with the requirements of the licensing laws; 10 and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore, be it

18 Sec. 1. Extension of temporary license. Resolved: That the Department of Environmental Protection shall extend until 20 September 15, 1995 the term of the temporary license for the municipal solid waste transfer station on Long Island.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

FISCAL NOTE

The extension of the temporary license held by the municipal solid waste transfer station operated by the Town of Long Island will result in an insignificant reduction of dedicated revenue to the Department of Environmental Protection from licensure renewal fees.
