
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 16, L.D. 3, Bill, "An Act to Grant an Extension of Time to Holders of Sea Urchin Licenses Who Have Attempted to Comply with the Requirement to Take a Competency Course"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the 5th line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "the course," and inserting in its place the following: "the course by January 31, 1995,"
