6	Whereas, a person who wishes to obtain a sea urchin license for 1995 must successfully complete a commercial underwater
8	handharvesting competency course by December 31, 1994; and
10	Whereas, the courses that are being offered in 1994 are full; and

14	extended, persons who have licenses will lose their licenses; and
16	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of

The purpose of this bill is to extend the sea urchin license of a person who has made a good faith effort to comply with the commercial underwater handharvesting competency course. To receive the extension, the person must have sent the application and the registration fee for enrollment in the course for 1994.
