**Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13065, sub-§2, ¶¶I and J, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 875, Pt. M, §§6 and 13, are amended to read:**

I. Subject to the approval of the commissioner, adopt, amend and repeal rules to carry out the purposes of this section; and

J. Undertake other activities that the commissioner considers appropriate and necessary to ensure the successful implementation of this section; and

**STATEMENT OF FACT**
