COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 22, L.D. 16, Bill, "An Act to Exempt Adaptive Equipment Installed in Motor Vehicles Operated by Wheelchair Users from the Motor Vehicle Excise Tax"

Amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 15 (page 1, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'15. Adaptive equipment. Adaptive equipment installed on a motor vehicle owned by a disabled person or the family of a disabled person to make that vehicle operable or accessible by a disabled person.'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

**'Sec. 4. Effective date.** This Act takes effect October 1, 1995.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment expands the exemption for adaptive equipment to any equipment that makes the vehicle operable or accessible by a disabled person and adds an effective date.
