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

**An Act to Decrease the Minimum Required Amount of Liability  
Insurance for Certain Intrastate Vehicles.**

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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4       **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2441, 5th ¶**, as amended by PL 1989, c. 135,  
is further amended to read:

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8       The commissioner may waive the requirements of any rule to  
cover any special circumstances, conditions or localities. The  
commissioner may not adopt a rule requiring a person transporting  
explosives within the State in a vehicle with a gross vehicle  
weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less to acquire a certificate  
of public liability insurance in excess of \$1,000,000.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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18       This bill prohibits the Commissioner of Public Safety from  
requiring a person transporting explosives intrastate only to  
have liability insurance coverage in excess of \$1,000,000.  
Currently, such persons are required to have coverage of at least  
20       \$5,000,000.
