Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2441, 5th ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 135, 4 is further amended to read:

The commissioner may waive the requirements of any rule to cover any special circumstances, conditions or localities. The commissioner may not adopt a rule requiring a person transporting explosives within the State in a vehicle with a gross vehicle
weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less to acquire a certificate of public liability insurance in excess of \$1,000,000.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill prohibits the Commissioner of Public Safety from requiring a person transporting explosives intrastate only to have liability insurance coverage in excess of \$1,000,000. Currently, such persons are required to have coverage of at least \$5,000,000.
