22	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting
24	the following:
26	'An Act to Increase the Debt Limit of the West Paris Water District'
28 30	Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:
32	'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local

36	Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have

4 0	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 29, L.D. 23

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 2 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. P&SL 1963, c. 83, §10, first ¶ is amended to read:

For accomplishing the purposes of this act, and for such other expenses as may be necessary for the carrying out of said these purposes, said the district, through its trustees, without vote of the inhabitants, is authorized to borrow money temporarily and to issue therefor its negotiable notes; and for the purpose of renewing and refunding the indebtedness so of paying any necessary expenses created, and liabilities incurred under the provisions of this act, including organizational and other necessary expenses and liabilities whether incurred by the district or the Town of West Paris, the district being authorized to reimburse said the Town of West Paris for any such expense incurred by it and in acquiring properties, paying damages, laying pipes, mains, aqueducts and conduits, constructing, maintaining and operating a water plant system and making renewals, additions, extensions or and improvements to the same and to cover interest payments during the period of construction, said the district, through its trustees, without the vote of its inhabitants, is also authorized to issue, from time to time, bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness of the district in one series, or in separate series, in such amount or amounts, bearing interest at such rate or rates, and having such terms and provisions as the trustees shall determine; provided the total outstanding indebtedness of the said district shall may not exceed the -- sum -- of -- \$300,000 \$1,000,000 at any one time sutstanding.

Sec. 2. Emergency clause; referendum; effective date. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when 38 approved only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the 40 legal voters within the West Paris Water District at a special or regular town meeting or election held prior to December 31, 42 1995. The election must be called, advertised and conducted according to the law relating to municipal elections, except that the registrar of voters is not required to prepare or the town 44 clerk to post a new list of voters. The registrar of voters must 46 be in session on the secular day next preceding the election. The town clerk of the town shall prepare the required ballots, on 48 which the town clerk shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following question:

"Do you favor increasing the debt limit of the West Paris Water District from \$300,000 to \$1,000,000?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed 6 against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion on the question.

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The results must be declared by the municipal officers of the Town of West Paris and due certificate of the results filed by the town clerk with the Secretary of State.

12 This Act takes effect immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at the election.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 16 statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

20 This bill requires the West Paris Water District to hold a public referendum. The additional costs of this state mandate
22 are likely to be relatively minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each
24 House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes and replaces the bill and amends the title to reflect the changes made. The bill removed the debt limit of the West Paris Water District. This amendment increases the debt limit from \$300,000 to \$1,000,000. The amendment also adds a mandate preamble, an emergency preamble, an emergency referendum clause and a fiscal note to the bill.
