

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. P&SL 1963, c. 83, §10, first ¶ is amended to read:**

6 For accomplishing the purposes of this act, and for such
8 other expenses as may be necessary for the carrying out of said
10 these purposes, said the district, through its trustees, without
12 vote of the inhabitants, is authorized to borrow money
14 temporarily and to issue therefor its negotiable notes; and for
16 the purpose of renewing and refunding the indebtedness so
18 created, of paying any necessary expenses and liabilities
20 incurred under the provisions of this act, including
22 organizational and other necessary expenses and liabilities
24 whether incurred by the district or the Town of West Paris, the
26 district being authorized to reimburse said the Town of West
28 Paris for any such expense incurred by it and in acquiring
 properties, paying damages, laying pipes, mains, aqueducts and
 conduits, constructing, maintaining and operating a water plant
 or system and making renewals, additions, extensions and
 improvements to the same and to cover interest payments during
 the period of construction, said the district, through its
 trustees, without the vote of its inhabitants, is also authorized
 to issue, from time to time, bonds, notes or other evidences of
 indebtedness of the district in one series, or in separate
 series, in such amount or amounts, bearing interest at such rate
 or rates, and having such terms and provisions as the trustees
 shall determine, ~~provided the total indebtedness of the said~~
 ~~district shall not exceed the sum of \$300,000 at any one time~~
 outstanding.
