Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6748-B, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

6 5. Temporary license. A 30-day temporary sea urchin boat
8 tender license may be granted to a person who fulfills the
10 requirements of this section and section 6748. The training
12 required under chapter 621, subchapter II does not apply to a
14 30-day temporary sea urchin boat tender license. The fee for a
16 temporary sea urchin boat tender license is \$25.
