**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

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**Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1708, sub-§3, ¶A-1,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 410, Pt. YY, §1, is repealed.

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**Sec. 2. 36 MRSA c. 370,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 410, Pt. YY, §2 and affected by §6, is repealed.

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**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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This bill repeals the gross receipts tax imposed on nursing homes and on restaurants licensed for on-premises consumption of liquor. Restaurants licensed for on-premises consumption of liquor would be returned to coverage under the sales tax.

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
