2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §1191, sub-§9** is enacted to read:

6 9. Deduction for lump sum settlements. Any unemployment
8 benefits payable to an individual who receives a lump sum
10 settlement under Title 39-A, chapter 5 must be reduced by the
12 amount of the lump sum settlement.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill requires the reduction of unemployment benefits to any individual who chooses to take a lump sum settlement of an award made under the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992.
