2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1922, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is repealed.
6	Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1922, sub-§§2 to 6, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, are amended to read:

10	2. Display rules. For purposes of vehicle-identification, in-addition-te-the-previsions-of-section-1951, a-motor-truck, truck-tractor-or-semitrailer commercial advertising, an owner or
12	operator of a motor vehicle may display an illuminated sign in accordance with rules adopted by the Commissioner of Public
14	Safety according to the Maine Administrative Procedure Act.
<b>L</b> 6	3. Standards. Among other standards determined by the Commissioner of Public Safety to be necessary to protect the
18	welfare and safety of the general public, an illuminated sign:
20	A. Must On a motor truck, truck tractor or semitrailer, must bear the name of the owner of the vehicle, the lesses
22	of the vehicle or the person for which the operator is transporting property or goods; and
24	B. May identify the cargo in transit-:and

28	C. On any motor vehicle, other than a motor truck, truck tractor or semitrailer, used for commercial purposes must
30	bear the name of the business.
32	4. Location of sign. An illuminated sign may only be displayed as follows:
34	A. On truck tractors, on the wind deflector on the roof of the truck tractor;
36	B. On a semitrailer, on the front portion of the

10	C. On a truck, on the front portion of the storage compartment above and behind the cab; and

14	D. On any other motor vehicle used for commercial purposes, as determined by the Commissioner of Public Safety.

5. Lights prohibited. An illuminated sign may not be lighted by a flashing, blinking or neon light and the sign may

not be illuminated when the motor vehicle is not being used.

6. Form, size and light of sign. An illuminated sign must be in a form, size and light se-as-net-to-distract-or-impair-the vision-of-the-operator-of-another-meter-vehicle to be determined by the Commissioner of Public Safety.
