28 30	necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,
32	two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'
34	Further amend the bill in section 2, in the 11th line (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "voters and,
36	for the purpose, the" and inserting in its place the following: 'voters. For the purpose of registration of voters, the'

40	Further amend the bill on page 2 by striking out all of the emergency clause before the statement of fact.
42	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
44	FISCAL NOTE
46	This bill requires the Sewer District of the Town of
48	Kennebunk to hold a public referendum and expands the territorial limits of the district. The additional costs of this state
50	mandate are relatively minor for the referendum and are likely to be significant for the services to be provided in the expanded
