### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4832, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1991, c. 546, §31, is further amended to read:

2. Exemption. Transactions that, under the laws of this State, are not subject to taxation in accordance with Part 3 are exempt from the fee imposed by subsection 1. Sales of any items that occur as part of a sale of a trailer, a mobile home or any motorized vehicle are exempt from the fee imposed by subsection 1. Sales of any items to be used in the business of a purchaser are exempt from the fee imposed by subsection 1.

This bill exempts from the recycling assistance fee office furniture and other furniture or equipment used by a business, such as displays, shelving and the like, used in the presentation or conduction of that business's operation.
